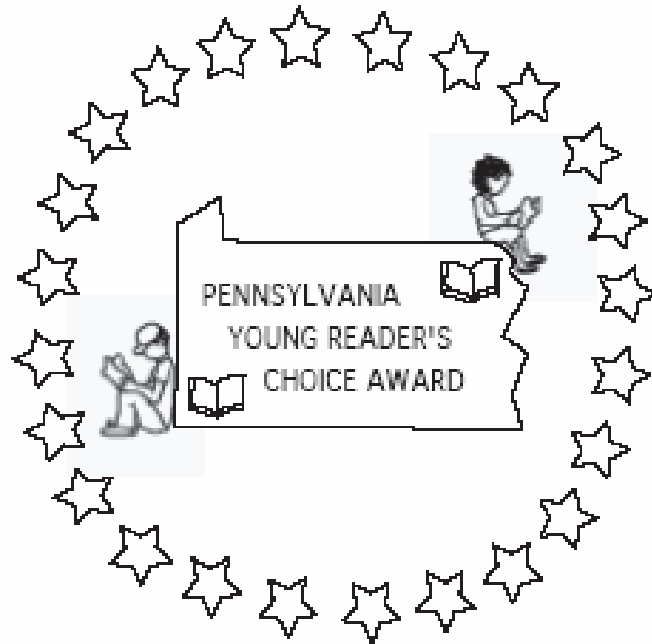
What is the purpose of the Pennsylvania Young Reader's Choice Award?

- VOTE by March 15th

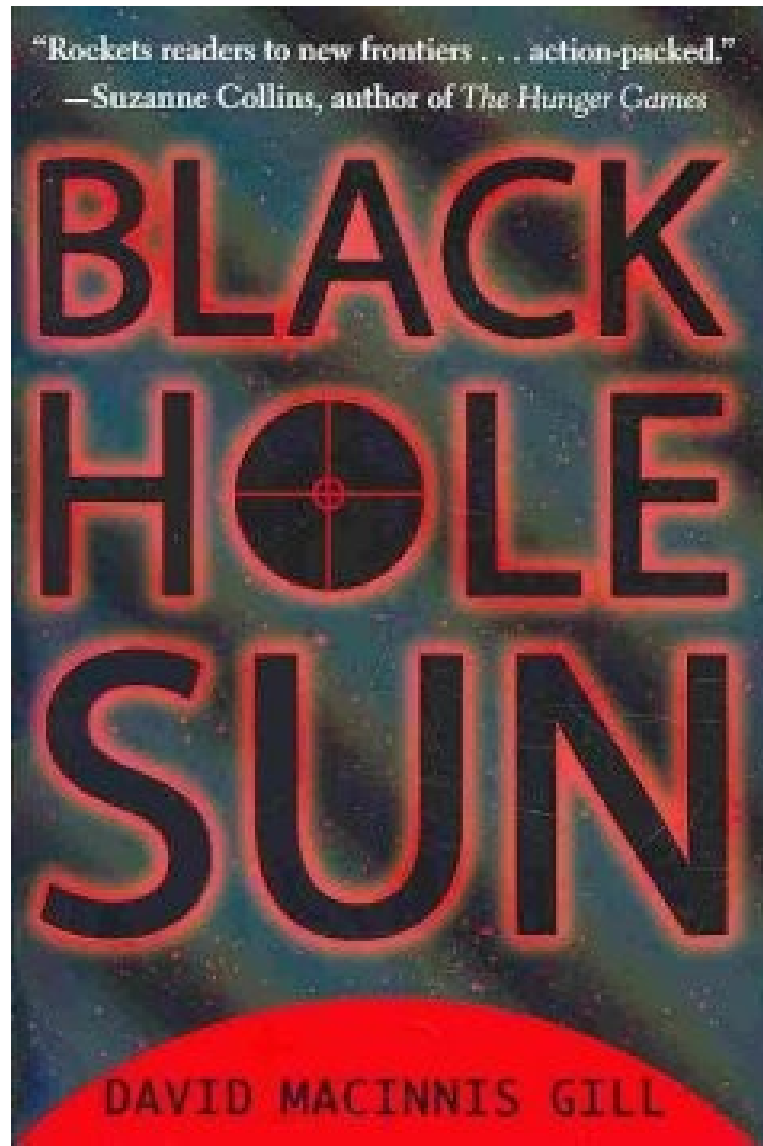
What happens to my Pennsylvania Young Reader's Choice vote?

- The winning book/author in each category is announced at our annual librarians conference each spring.

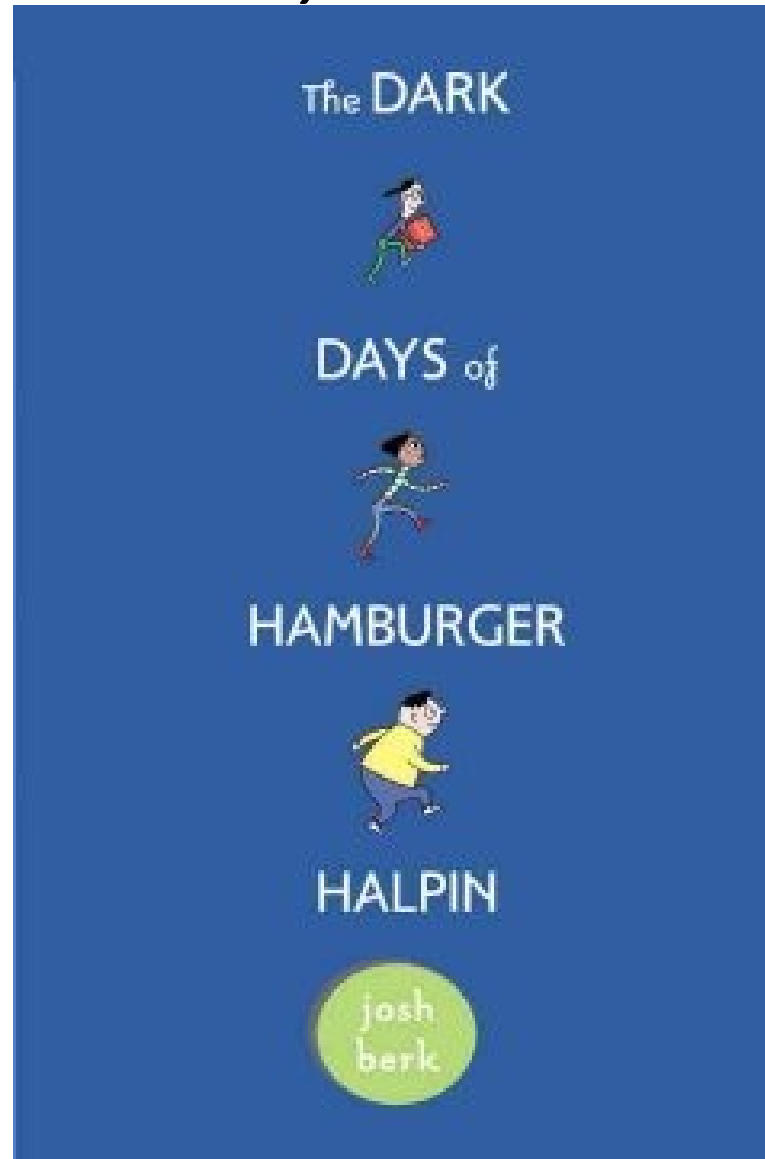
